

BONUS SKETCHBOOK IDEAS: 100 PROPS

This list is taken from the Pose Drawing SparkBook by Cedric Hohnstadt, a super-charged sketchbook designed to help you put more life and personality into your drawings.

Each prop has been carefully chosen for its potential to give you several entertaining situations for your characters to act out. Take a flashlight for example: Your character could be shining it under their chin while telling a scary story around a campfire; or making shadow puppets; or signaling for help; or just trying to see in the dark. How might you draw the pose differently if your character is lost, or playing a nighttime game, or searching for something valuable?

Use this list as a springboard for entertaining poses and situations, and then have fun drawing!
